Collaboration is the key ... preserving and strengthening the P2Rx national network makes good sense.

P2Rx MAKES CONNECTIONS

P2Rx effectively provides communication lines among local, tribal, and state programs; non-profits, educators, and businesses; regional P2 offices and national EPA headquarters. These connections save isolated programs from costly duplication of efforts and create a network for time- and labor-saving collaborations.

P2Rx SAVES TIME AND MONEY

P2Rx collaborations provide critical support to pollution prevention programs with limited budgets by augmenting their resources. Because P2Rx can meet their demand for organized, quality information and pertinent technical resources, these P2 programs are more effective.

P2Rx DELIVERS TOP-NOTCH INFORMATION

Through a national database, P2Rx delivers peer-reviewed information tailored to user needs. Today, Mercury, EPP, Tribal, and H2E programs (among others) utilize the well-developed centralized data management system of P2Rx. Without costly duplication, the established P2Rx knowledge base can be extended to other EPA programs such as Green Suppliers' Network, Green Chemistry, High Production Volume Chemicals, Resource Conservation Challenge, or Design for the Environment.

P2Rx PROVIDES TOOLS FOR P2 ADVOCACY

P2Rx measurement tools evaluate and share environmental outcomes providing programs with aggregated data that clearly demonstrates the value of pollution prevention initiatives.
