1.1. Programs Admin Forms - Overview

The programs directory keeps track of the organizations associated with P2 in the region and programs listed for the purposes of the Topic Hubs, such as for the Where to Go for Help section.

The web group has created an administration form to make the task easier. Regional centers should update or add programs as needed.

Go to www.p2rx.org/admin and log in. Click on “Programs Admin”

From this page the administrator is able to **add new programs, view, edit, and delete existing programs and access the *Where to go for Help* (WTGFH) information (you can associate or disassociate the program with any of the Topic Hubs. If associated with the Topic Hub, the program will appear in that Hub’s WTGFH section.) You can also check links, view the list of contact e-mails, view program**

addresses and contact names, and choose whether or not to display the designation for programs that are members of NPPR on your regional Programs Directory site.

1.2. Add Program

Once **Add New Program** has been selected from the main Program Administration page, the user will be forwarded to the *Information #1* section.

1.2.1. Add Program - Information #1

1.2.2. Add Program - Information #2

1.2.4. Add Program - Program Types

This section is to associate program type(s) with the Program. An administrator may also add new program types relevant to the Program (see 1.2.4.1 below). Once programs have been selected and/or added, submit the form to proceed to *Authority and Free Keywords* section.

1.2.5. Add Program – Authority and Free Keywords

Click on keywords you want associated with the program. The administrator may add and/or create additional keywords relevant to the program. Click “submit at the bottom of the screen for each list. (Every letter has its own list). When you click submit, the keyword will appear in the left-hand section of the table. You can continue to look at all the keyword lists. When finished, click on the statement, “click here to keep these settings” and the keywords will be saved in association with that program.



1.7. Programs Administration – Edit

Administrators may edit an organization program’s information here. Once changes have been made you must click on *Update* to save the new information. The program will forward you automatically to the *Information #2* section.



1.8. Programs Administration – Delete

1.9. Programs Administration – WTGFH
