I. Topic Hubs

The P2 Coordinators are looking for plan or statement of where the Centers are headed with Topic Hubs.

Regions 5 and 7 are already moving towards LibGuides, and Region 9 is looking into it. The Sustainable Lodging on the NING site is another strategy of reinvigorating the Topic Hubs. Region 7 will also be looking at using Word Press as another option. Region 7 will also be moving Substain Updates to LibGuides.

Those on the call agreed that the Center's will archive those Topic Hubs that they have not done an update to in the last 3 years. Those updates do not include fixing broken links.

The question was raised as to what folks should do that are transferring their topic hubs to a new platform. It was suggested there could be an index page that points to everything P2Rx does on a particular topic.

Joy suggested adding information on the topic hub page of p2rx.org about the hubs, what they are, what they were meant for, and about the hubs moving forward.

III. Social Bookmarking/Delicious

Delicious is no longer feeding onto P2Rx.org. It does not regularly work on the page. At one point there was the questions of whether or not Delicious will be around. There has been a drop off in the number of contributors, so we need to look at marketing. NEMOA says it will probably take at least half a day to fix. Folks felt that Delicious places new content on the website.
