The National Pollution Prevention Roundtable (NPPR) is interested in continuing its partnership with the Pollution Prevention Resource Exchange (P2Rx), as was formally entered into with the signing of a Memorandum of Understanding in 2004.

Finally, as a follow-up on our shared commitment under the MOU, NPPR is designating Thomas Vinson as the liaison between the NPPR and P2Rx.. He will be expected to communicate on a periodic basis about the successes of our collaborative efforts and how they can be advanced.
